MAJOR AWARDS ENTRY FORM **CPRS Notified Student Award of Excellence**

Established jointly by CPRS and Notified, this award recognizes student excellence in the PR field. Eligible students must be currently enrolled in their final year (or equivalent) of a recognized, full-time PR program, instructed in a Canadian post-secondary institute. Students must be studying at an undergraduate, diploma or certificate level.



Proof of enrollment must accompany the entry form.

Eligibility Criteria: The student must be a member of CPRS National.

Program coordinators or instructors can nominate candidates by submitting a 300-500 word summary of how the nominee met the following criteria:

- clear understanding and application of the principles of PR theory •
- demonstrates professionalism
- leadership in scholastic activities
- committed to pursuing a career in PR and demonstrates an ability to contribute to the status and • acceptance of the profession
- students must be enrolled in the program full-time •

Winners receive a certificate and \$2,000 prize offered by Notified.
