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ELIGIBILITY

As this Award recognizes ethics and integrity in the practice of public relations, all aspects of <u>CPRS' Code of Professional Standards</u> should be demonstrated by recipients, including:

This award should go to someone **who has been in the profession for a while** and include examples from the individual's years of practice where they have fulfilled the award criteria (i.e. **evidence**) backed by commentary from other public relations professionals, or the nominee's colleagues would help to capture the spirit and commitment the nominee has demonstrated over a sustained period of time.

CRITERIA

- 1. Maximum three (3) page submission. (1,000 words).
- 2. Support for nomination should include testimonials from colleagues, clients or letters of support.
- 3. Clear examples of ethical behaviour referencing the Code.
